Code: L1 - 10

(Playground guidelines resume once pupils enter the playground after eating lunch)

- 1. I should show respect for others (House Captains, pupils and staff)
- 2. I should walk sensibly to the dining hall in single file, without overtaking
- 3. I should enter the dining hall safely, without running
- 4. I should stay in order at the hatch line, behaving sensibly and respectfully
- 5. I should talk quietly while inside the dining hall
- 6. I should always say please and thank you and be polite towards the dinner supervisors
- 7. I should try everything on my plate, being mindful not to rush my meal and set a good example to other children
- 8. I should use good table manners at all times
- P5 P7 pupils should eat their dinner and when finished, clear dinner plates, cups and utensils sensibly and quietly
- P5 P7 pupils should exit the dining hall safely and carefully, walking across the zebra crossing and down the pupil footpath to the KS2 playground.
